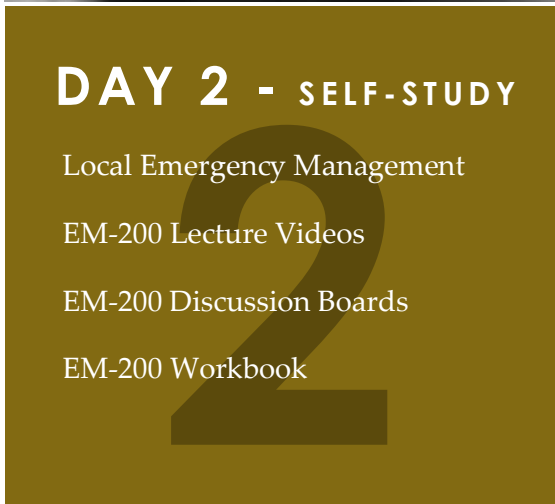
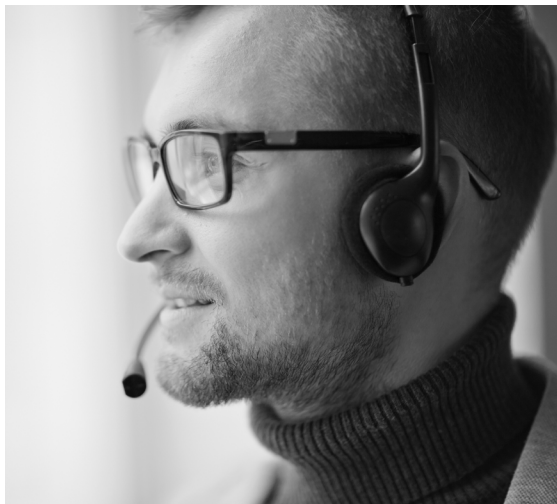

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT IN ONTARIO

Introduction and Overview

You will receive an email activating your Shield account 7 days prior to the course start date. Participants can log in using the email and password they initially registered with. The course is split into 3 days and also requires some pre-course work be completed. Your course site will break down the program of study into daily activities. Day 1 and Day 2 are asynchronous learning days which means the activities are all pre-recorded and accessible at your own pace. Some candidates choose to complete Day 1 and 2 during the first 2 days of the course, while others prefer to spend a couple of hours each day during the week before the course begins. How you choose to complete the first 2 days is completely up to you and your situation, but the work must be done prior to attending the live class on Day 3.

Day 3's live class will include all of the exercises, discussions, exams and mock emergencies dictated by Emergency Management Ontario (EMO) for certification in their EM-200 course. EMO further requires that students fully participate in these learning activities and also achieve a minimum score of 70% on the certification exam. Exam topics will be fully discussed throughout the course and students will write the exam with confidence in their abilities and knowledge.
